



## District Funding of Leadership Training Costs

Financial Grants are available to support the training of Sutton District Scout Leaders. Grants will be made to reimburse 50% of the course fees for Scout Association modular training courses and 50% of the course fees for the basic first aid training course provided within Greater London South West County. Grants to help fund other training course fees may also be made at the discretion of and subject to prior approval by the Sutton District Executive Committee.

Applications for reimbursement of modular training, basic first aid and other approved course fees should be made using this form after the courses have taken place. Applications should be sent to the District Treasurer and will be processed twice yearly (the application deadlines are 30 June and 31 December). All payments will be made by cheque to the Scout Group or Explorer Scout bank account.

Applications for approval of grants towards the cost of other courses should be made in writing before the courses take place and will be considered at the following District Executive Committee meeting (normally within three months of application).
